



Speaker: Phillip Wilson of Danvers Rotary

Introduced by Carlos
Background:

- Grew up in Gary, Indiana
- Joined Ridgewood Rotary (NJ) in 1984
- Founded the Rotary Club of the Palisades
- Major donor to the Rotary Foundation
- District 7490 Polio Plus Chair
- Lives in Peabody with his wife, Jane

Phillip's Story:

- His brother fell ill returning home from camp as a child and sadly passed in the hospital
- Phillip became sick shortly after and was diagnosed with polio
- Recovering from the fever doesn't mean being done with its effects
- Phillip represents an unusual case — does not use either arm or his left hand; relies on the fingers of his right hand

· After college, joined the Peace Corps and was sent to Kenya to teach high school — 90 miles north of Nairobi, "in the boonies"

· Managed everything independently; befriended a nurse at the local hospital

who eventually proposed to him — he said yes without hesitation!

· They are now both Danvers Rotary members and have had a fabulous life together

Carlos's Story:

· Born and raised in Colombia
· Contracted polio at 9 months old during a family holiday — exposed during an outbreak, possibly due to incomplete immunization or a stale dose

· Virus affected his hips and both legs

· Started walking at age 3, with his father teaching him in braces

· His father always called him a "tough guy" — became his first words and a lifelong source of strength

· At age 10, underwent leg-lengthening surgery — each day for 60 days, a millimeter is turned to expand the gap and allow new bone to grow in

· Spent all of 5th grade recovering in bed; friends visited after school with class notes

· Father had to sell the car and belongings to cover surgery costs

· With physical therapy, his hip and right leg improved significantly

About Polio

· Almost unknown in America today, but not long ago it was devastating

· Spreads through water, food, and close contact — no FDA-approved antiviral treatment

· Some cases so severe children required

· First vaccine developed 1954, found 90% effective — cases plummeted

· Oral polio vaccine adopted in US and abroad in 1961

· All 50 states require the polio vaccine for school attendance

· Polio still circulates in parts of the world — it's only a plane ride away

· Rising vaccine skepticism is creating new vulnerabilities

· A few years ago, a traveler brought polio to New York State — an unvaccinated young adult ended up paralyzed

· The message: Don't take a chance. It's not worth it.

Call to Action: Join the Polio Plus Society!

· Set up an annual or monthly recurring donation

· Membership = pledge of \$100 over 12 months
