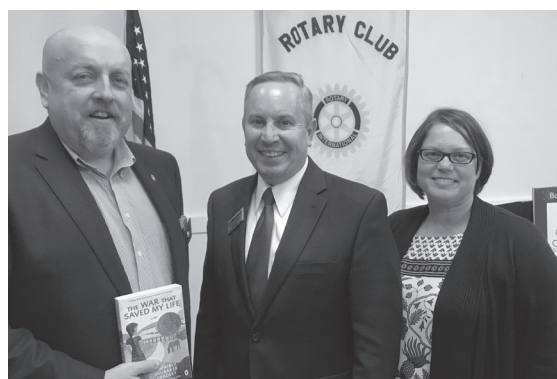

### Speaker

- This week's speaker was Endicott Col-

lege President Steven R. DiSalvo, Ph.D., the seventh president of Endicott College. He was most recently the president of St. Anselm's College in New Hampshire and prior to that, Wisconsin's Marian University. Dr. DiSalvo also comes to Endicott with a wealth of experience beyond the sphere of higher education, having served as president and CEO of the Hopewell Group, a leading philanthropic advising firm, and as executive director of the Joe Torre Safe At Home Foundation, which is committed to helping children heal from the effects of domestic violence and abuse. He has also formerly worked as executive vice president at Junior Achievement of New York, which is dedicated to preparing and inspiring young people to succeed in a global economy.

DiSalvo holds three degrees from Fordham University: a Ph.D. in educational

leadership and administration, an MBA from the university's Gabelli School of Business, and a B.S. in psychology. He previously worked in advancement at Fordham as well as at Loyola University Chicago and Fairfield University. Informed by his education and experience at multiple institutions, DiSalvo maintains a deep belief in providing college access to all students and ensuring that the college community is diverse, inclusive, and reflective of the world in which we live. His philosophy is centered on one common question: are we doing our best to serve our students?
