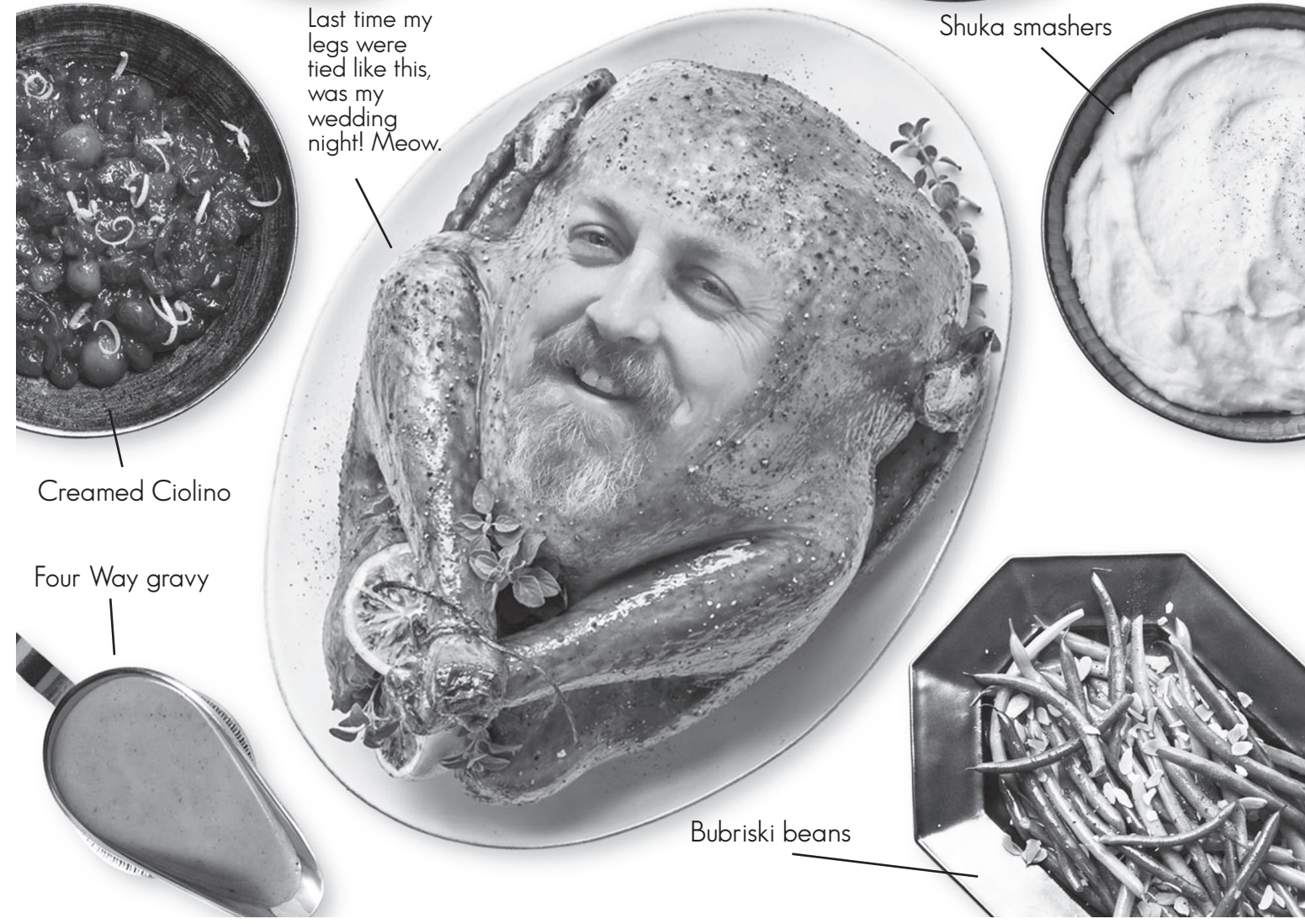

Speaker:

This week's speaker is Michael
Goldstein from North Shore Com-
munity College's (NSCC) Year Up
Program. Year Up enables young
adults to move from minimum wage
to meaningful careers in just one
year. It has expanded to the North
Shore in January 2020 at the Lynn
campus of NSCC. Young adults
participate in their one-year pro-
gram, which includes college credits
and a stipend, a six-month intern-
ship at a top employer, and exten-
sive support to prepare students
for success in high-demand careers,
from help desk to finance to project
management to quality assurance
to cyber.

They have a program in Boston
and are launching this program at
NSCC in January, starting with IT/
help desk training and will move
into business in September 2020.
The organization tries to close the
opportunity divide between com-
panies with jobs and individuals
who need jobs. Students spend 5
months in classes and 6 months
at an internship. They have high
expectations and high support, but
they are fined for infractions (sounds
familiar). They learn invaluable soft
skills and professional skills. Students
have a \$900 stipend so they don't
need to stretch themselves too thin,
and companies pay \$26,500 to

host an internship. Internship sites
include Eastern Bank, Bank of
America, Salesforce, Google, etc.
Contact Chris Martin if you would
like to host an internship. Carlos
Reyes is an alum of the program,
interned at Ebsco, and is now on
the recruitment team for Year Up.
A faculty member from NSCC in
Lynn teaches the classes. There is a
clothing closet students have ac-
cess to, so they can dress for the job
they want. They want to transform
the way companies hire and train
companies about how to onboard
and retain this talent pool. 4700
students participate in this program
nationally, and the NSCC program
needs 20 more students for the
January start, so refer students to
Michael Goldstein.
