




Zoom Meeting Called to Order: 12.17

Rachel Hand gave the Invocation with thought-provoking self-care questions

Guest Speaker: Mayor Cahill

Gave a great update on Beverly's battle with COVID-19

Mayor Cahill is not confident in the reported numbers because there is not enough testing to feel real confident in them:

Biggest Problem area has been congregate living facilities; Care-One & Oceanview Assisted Living cited as examples

505 Positive Tests

68 Deaths: 12 from the community and 46 from assisted living facilities

He feels that the number of deaths is undercounted

Testing is the big piece to re-opening and staying open

City is working hard to help business community reopen safely

Q&A with Mayor Cahill Sue Gabriel commended the

mayor for his approach and messaging throughout this pandemic

In response, Mayor Cahill commended the state leadership and the Beverly City Council as well as

other local mayors who he speaks to daily and other Greater Boston mayors who he speaks to 3x per week

Brother Ed asked Mayor Cahill to speak about Beverly's approach in the supermarkets; Beverly was a leader in implementing these policies

Derek Maxfield asked about how Beverly's plan will compare to the State's plan; some issues we need to follow state orders while others give the city some flexibility; a case-by-case situation

Eric asked about the implications on the budget; Mayor is hoping to get local aid number by the end of May; wants the City to be able to pass an entire budget as opposed to one for just July; City is planning for 15% cut in state aid; City planning for significant cuts to excise taxes collected, meals taxes collected, and building permit fees; wants to avoid layoffs

Peter Hersee asked about effect on real estate taxes; plan on tax increases

The Scribe asked about reopening of the schools; preliminary talks so far; nothing figured out; discussions of various plans; extra classrooms, stagaered days, etc.

Rachel Hand discussed homelessness and evictions

Work on the 3 intersections (Henry's, by Dr. Beckman's office, and BG&T) remains on track to start construction by end of June
