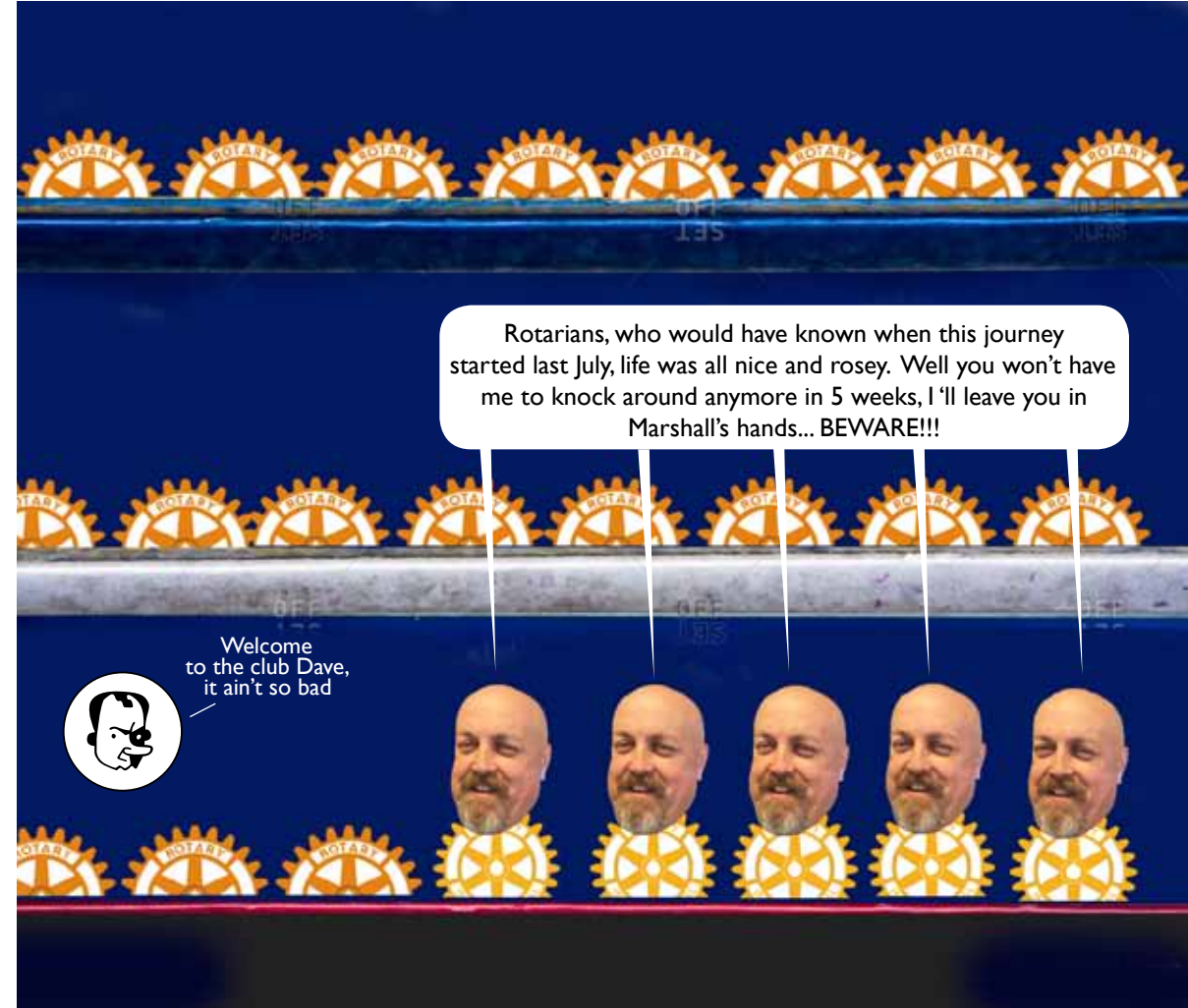
Note: Maia has given a talk to our Rotary group in the past. If you have previously attended one of her events you know she excels at finding fantastic wines at great prices...hidden gems!
