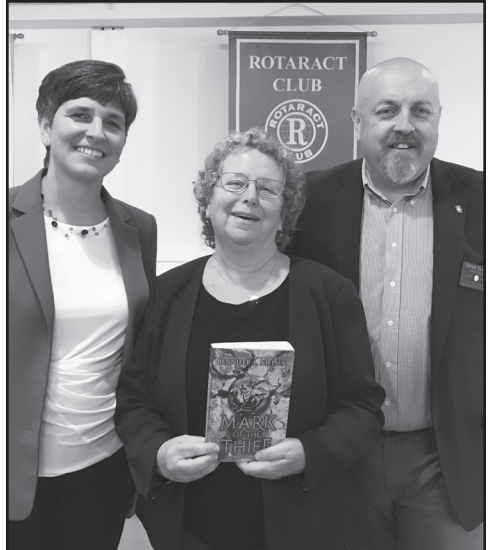
Its time for some football (Insert Kerry Underwood singing a football song here)
