# **Rotary Work Project at Whole foods!**





They have a lot of juniors involved which provides opportunity for continuity for the group.

Rotary has committed to promoting the event, underwrote a \$1000 line of credit for purchase of toys/games and Learning Express and Rotary members have pitched in and the line of credit is up to \$3000- with a goal of \$5000. Peter reminded us that it will be the 10th Polar Plunge and the total raised over the years is over \$814,000. The goal is to raise \$1M by July 2020. All donations are matched 2:1 by the Gates Foundation.

Rotary has reduced Polio cases by 99.9% since 1988.

Peter asked the club who will be plunging this year. Dave Olson seemed to commit again and then Dylan Jones raised his hand- Peter will hold Dylan to that!

Cost of vaccination is just 60 cents.

Peter thanked Beverly Rotary for its commitment to the Plunge, and encouraged more of us to plunge, support and even just how up to support and to experience & enjoy the energy of the event.
