

Karen is the general manager of the North Shore Music Theatre, and serves on numerous boards. Today she shared her story with us of the horrific last seven months.


She and her husband were early sufferers of Covid, and tragically Steven was among the first to die of the disease in the state. She has just learned that her sister and brother-in-law have tested positive as well. Initial diagnosis was slow... they were quite fatigued, but medical professionals did not think it was serious. When they were admitted, professionals did not know best way to treat it. Ultimately a blood transfusion saved her life.

During her battle with Covid, Karen woke up to having lost her husband, father-inlaw, and Don Kelley. She suffered terrible nightmares. Felt her husband's presence and continues to do so. Difficult to walk after being bedridden, and she "woke up manic", but has now settled down. She also discovered that the world had changed... restaurants had closed, everyone has been laid off for now at NSMT, but they are hopeful for the future.

Now Karen strives to live in a place of gratitude. She had a great love with Steve, which she celebrates, and said "tomorrow is promised to no one". She has no nerve damage, and is mentally fit. Continues to feel husband around her, who continues to make his presence known as a guiding force. She finds comfort in that. Measures her oxygen daily, and suggests others do as well (get an oximeter!). Singing voice is somewhat affected, but she's good. Lost her FOMO. Remains very cautious, thinks if anyone can catch it twice it would be her. Major shutdown ahead? Don't be lax, wear your mask, it will be part of our culture for a while.

The meeting was adjourned at 1:11 pm.




