Worldwide Adventures of Handly

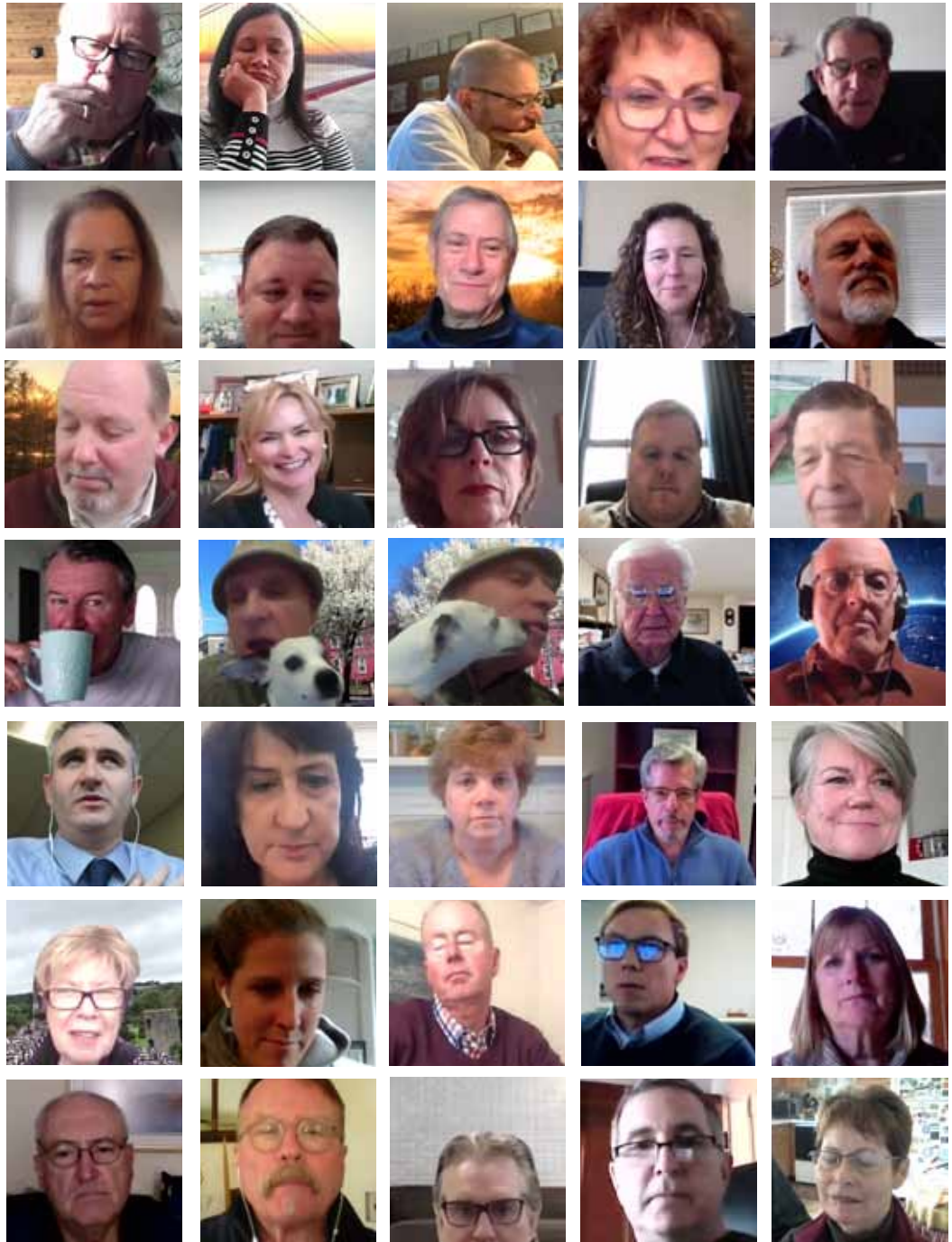
