

Rotational shelter model at founding; emergency shelter from the beginning; day center during the day and then church at night-prevents the need for shelters; communities response to end homelessness

2 Main Programs

Emergency Shelter-families in need of shelter; privately funded so they can provide shelter to those denied by the state; 50% applying for state shelter get denied-250-300 families per month denied

COVID-turned things upside down

Had to put families at the day center; could not use the churches

Has maintained the ability to provide shelter for families

Andy Goldberg was the savior-needed properties and Rachel turned to Andy

Andy had a house that opened up; open house on Sunday; will allow them to have 2 families in the house and office space for staff

Throughout pandemic getting calls because people being bullied by landlords to get out

Childcare is biggest barrier for people to avoid homelessness

Shelter Diversion-we do not want people in shelter;
