Several million Christians were killed . Mr. Buol lost most of his family and was separated from his surviving brother with whom he was reunited in 2014. Both were in the US. Mr Bull wrote a book about

"I was Just A quiet Little Boy" in the hopes to share with the world the genocide which continues today .Mr. Buol described the terror and challenges of escaping S Sudan prosecution, arriving in the US and the difficulty in getting an education and finding work. He currently lives in Lynn and has worked in home care and more recently at Endicott College as a dishwasher.


