BEVERLY ROTARY CLUB FOUNDATION SCHOLARSHIPS

The Beverly Rotary Club Foundation will be awarding to deserving Beverly residents who are high school seniors, scholarships totaling approximately \$25,000, with individual awards ranging in size from \$1,000 up to as much as \$10,000. To be considered, applications must be emailed or postmarked no later than April 4, 2018.

The scholarships are given to assist local students in meeting the expenses associated with furthering their education. Scholarships are available to graduating high school seniors and preparatory school students who will be enrolling as full-time students in a four-year or two-year degree granting program. The following criteria will be applied in selecting scholarship awardees:

- 1. Scholarships will be awarded to students who reside in Beverly, Massachusetts.
- 2. A broad range of academic, extra-curricular, community and work experience will be considered.
- 3. The financial needs of each student will be reviewed and will be an important consideration in the choice of scholarship recipients. Therefore, all applicants are required to submit a <u>complete copy</u> of the Student Aid Report (SAR) portion of the Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA). The information to be considered will include gross family income, debt, equity, etc. Extenuating financial considerations or hardships should be explained.
- 4. Children of Rotarians are **not** eligible to receive awards.
- Finalists for all awards will be interviewed by members of the Scholarship Committee of the Beverly Rotary Club. The interview is an essential part of the decision-making process.

Completed applications and three (3) letters of recommendation must be postmarked or emailed by the **April 4, 2018 deadline** to:
