Speaker

We had the pleasure of welcoming Del-
phine Minogue, owner of Delphine’s
Kitchen in downtown Beverly. Delphine
shared her 30-year journey in the culi-
nary world, which began at the
Eitel Culinary School in Montpelier,
France. After earning her degree in culi-
nary arts, she ventured to the U.S. to
establish herself as a private chef and
caterer, working throughout Boston
and the North Shore. In early
2020, she became the Executive Chef of
Chive Events, where she played a key
role in developing
partnerships with local farms and busi-
nesses. Now, at Delphine’s Kitchen, she
and her team take pride in

offering culinary creativity and contrib-
uting positively to the Beverly commu-
nity they are proud to call
home.

During her talk, Delphine spoke about
her busy work schedule, balancing
between 60 to 75 hours a week, serving
a growing number of customers, and
even volunteering around Beverly. Her
restaurant focuses on sustainability, us-
ing locally sourced ingredients, as well
as some from France, and ensuring all
packaging is compost able. Despite
the challenges of losing staff recently,
Delphine and her small team continue
to manage the kitchen with passion,
catering to events and offering a menu
filled with diverse options like sand-
wiches, salads, and her specialty au-
thentic French crêpes. She is currently
seeking a full-time baker to join her
team. If anyone knows of one please
let her know.

Delphine shared that as a business
owner, she’s involved in all aspects of
the operation, even doing the
dishes when needed. She also men-
tioned that her decision to come to the
U.S. was driven by the opportunity to
become a respected chef, which was
difficult to achieve in France without
spending years doing menial tasks in a
restaurant like peeling potatoes for 3
years. Today, her gluten free selections
and unique offerings set her apart, and
she continues to serve incredible food
to the Beverly community.


Almiris Verga was the raffle winner
