ZINK: The sink. Example: "I'm tired of seeing dirty dishes in da zink all da time.





Given the average attendance at each meal (35-50) there remains an ongoing need for basis food amongst our community. Funding for theses meals come from private donations, each church's budget, grants and community churches which volunteer to prepare meals.

Most of the dinner attendees are adults and primarily adult males attend the community lunches.

Several good questions came from the audience. Rotarians were humbly enlightened thanks to the panelists.
