
Dear Matt,

While lason was in rehab, he wrote his #1 bestselling book "Stop Thinking Like That: No Matter What''. The success of the book has given ason platforms all across the world to share the mission of his growing movement – Motivational Recovery.

lason shared how he is now a motivational speaker and performance coach, as well as becoming a certi-

fied Recovery Coach and Peer Specialist. He works with individuals within 43 group homes that his non-profit company, Bay Cove Human Services, serves throughout the Boston area.
