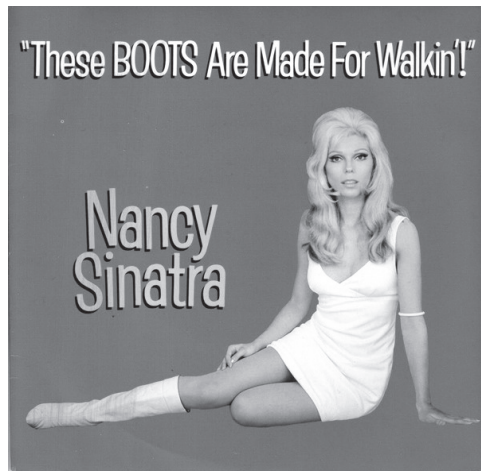

- Rich Jones for being Matt Blanchard's Little League coach years ago.

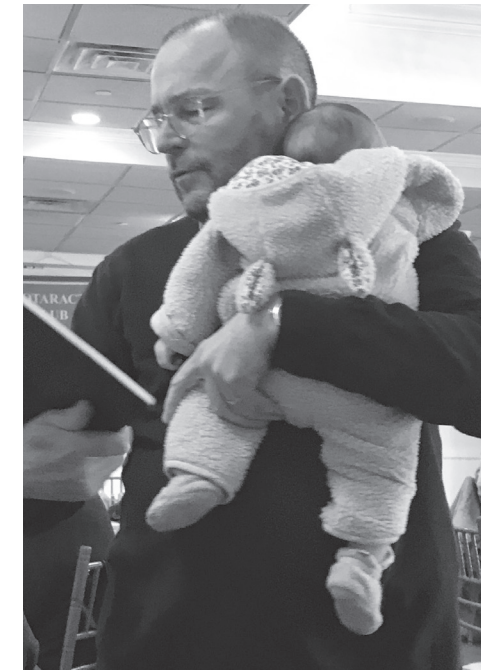
### Speaker:
