Speakers

After being served a wonderful lunch by the fabulous culinary arts students from Essex Technical High School, our speakers today were Heidi Riccio and Bonnie Carr, both in administration at Essex Technical High School. We had a thorough overview of all the programming that is going on at the school as well as some hopes for the future.

The school serves Essex, Middlesex and Suffolk counties. There are seventeen communities considered sending schools, meaning that those communities are able to send students for any course discipline and thirty five surrounding communities, that are able to send students to Essex if they are looking to obtain education in agricul-

ture. The school has about 1600 students and receives 1200 applications for 400 slots in any incoming freshman class.

The school offers twenty five career education programs. The students are able to earn college credit while in high school and along the way are able to take advantage of internships, apprenticeships and co-op programs.

They are also able to earn some certifications while in high school that allow some students to work while in high school or hit the ground running at graduation.

The school works very closely with community colleges, unions and work force development forums to ensure that the education being offered will allow the student to be employed in and area that is needed and thriving. If you are looking for a second career, can you say land surveyor.

They also offer adult education for re-training or fun. The school has been smart in developing a few revenue streams to offset costs, thus being able to teach real world skills and keep costs lower for the sending communities.

To say the least it was a very impressive presentation. If you would like to learn more, visit the school's website.
