



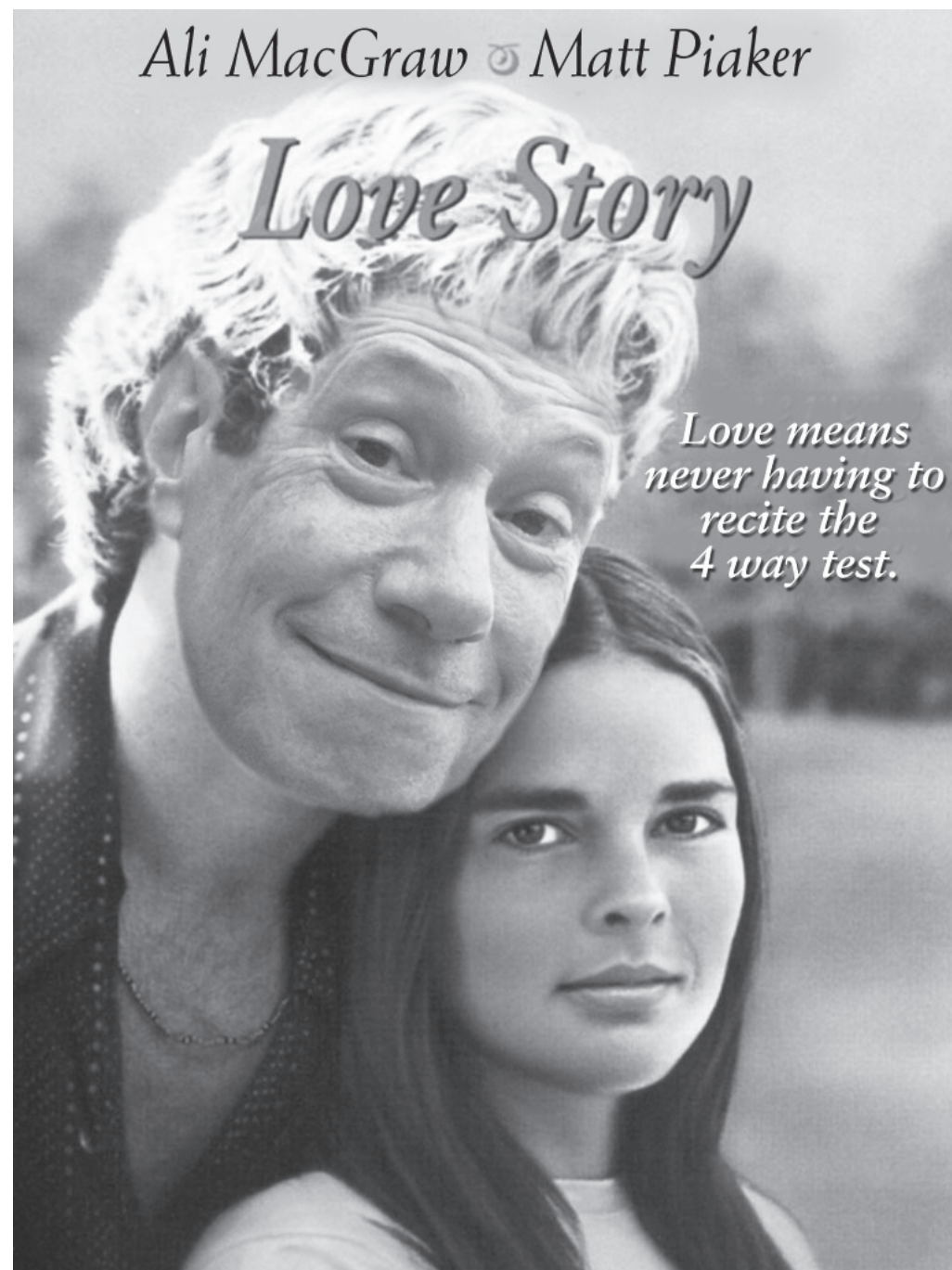

ADL has 25 Regional offices in the U.S. and headquartered in New York City

ADL fights hate for good through Investigation, Education and Advocacy

Their Education programs include anti-bias and anti-bullying, A World of Difference (where over 100 schools are participating), No Place for Hate, and Words to Action
ADL is the largest non-governmental training program for law enforcement

Hate crimes increased 17% from 2017 to 2018

427 reported hate crimes in MA in 2017

Fall River Jewish cemetery was vandalized last month...ADL organized vigil for the community

ADL works closely with schools to help them anticipate, communicate, investigate and educate about hate crimes

Their response to hate crimes on college campuses is through their Hate Uncycled program

How to report an incident: first call 911 if you or someone is in immediate danger. Then go to ADL website and fill out a report. For cyber incidents- take screenshots, keep records, report to the site/organization/platform where you see the incident as well.
