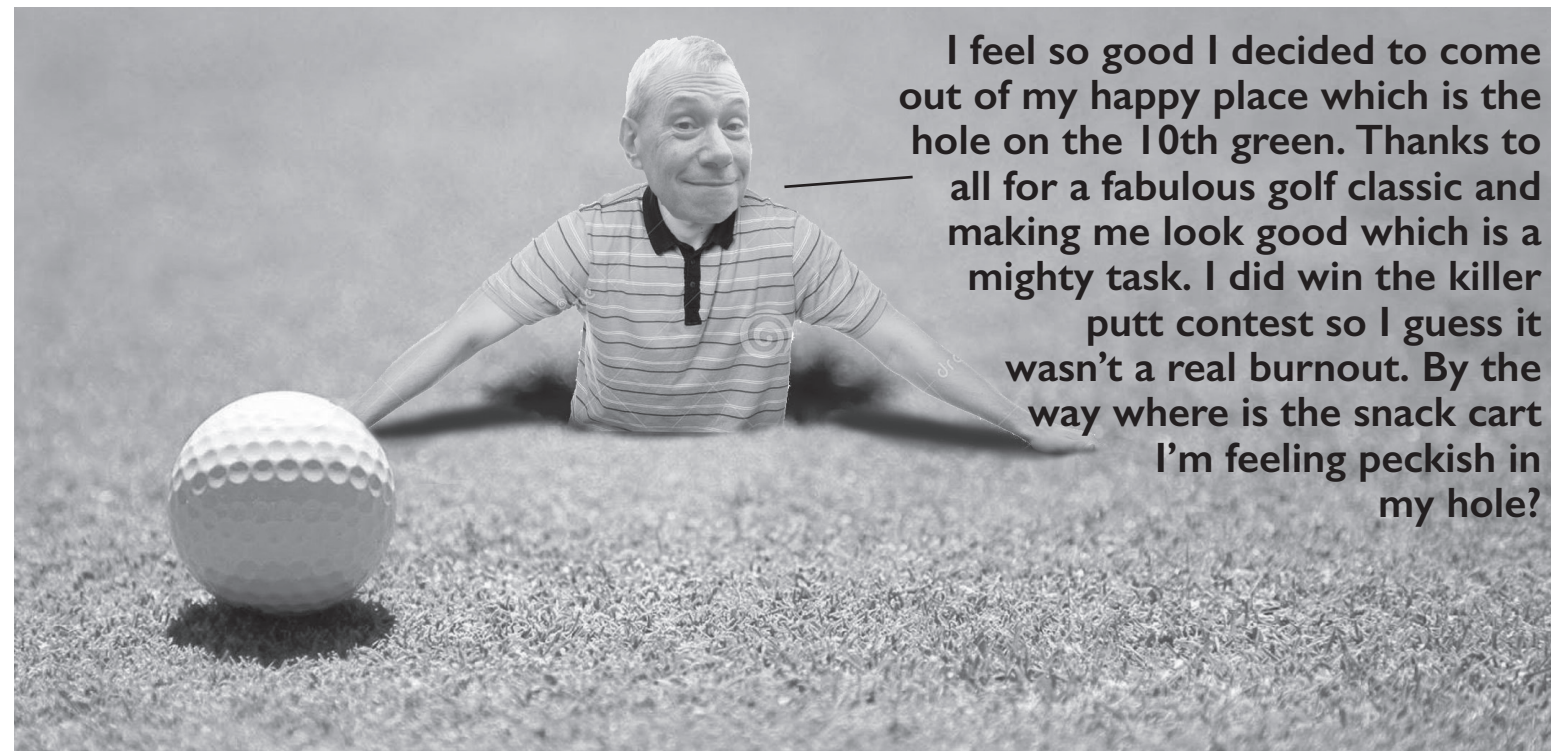
Last weeks speaker
