Topics included facts on work shortages in state and NSCC helping to fill those gaps in employment. Striving to get more people in workforce , more diversity and FREE upscaling of employees.

MassReconnect is a program \$20m initiative to help adults earn degree or certificate for free. Designed as a last dollar Award.

Eligibility includes 25+ age, Mass resident for 1+ year, no previous associate or bachelors degree or equivalent. complete FAFSA form, enroll at least 6 credits, maintain satisfactory academic progress.

- Cosmetology Clock Hour Program
- Developmental Disabilities Certificate
- Emergency Medical Technician Certificate
