



# The Swierczynski Swizzle Schtick

This Saturday is the first evan HOLIDAY BOURBON BOUNCE, pass the word. Better yet, pass the Bourbon Balls! That's right, Kentucky's only enduring contribution to culture (OK, maybe the Derby ranks in there) comes to mind when the holiday season and bouncing Rotarians roll around. Some are enrobed in chocolate; others wear a halved nut on their heads - I say son, I'm talking bourbon balls not the Rotarians - but the key to packing a festive punch is to soak your nuts in bourbon and add a generous pour to the dough itself. Like those rolling Rotarians, bourbon balls are chilled not cooked . Here are the assembly directions, batteries not included: you need 1 cup pecans;  $\frac{3}{4}$  cup bourbon, divided; 2 cups Nilla Wafers crumbed; <sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub> cup Dutch-process cocoa powder, divided; 1/2 cup confectioners' sugar, divided; and 1/4 cup corn syrup. Soak the pecans in half the bourbon. After a couple of hours, drain and drink or reserve the bourbon - your call – and then toast the nuts in the oven. Chop up the nuts and combine in a mixing bowl with the remaining bourbon (if there is any), the thriller-in-the-Nilla crumbs, half the cocoa powder, half the sugar, and all of the corn syrup. Stir until smooth. Using a heaping tablespoon portion, roll the dough into 3/4-inch balls. Combine the remaining cocoa powder and sugar and coat each ball. Put the balls on a baking sheet and chill for at least 2 hours. Go and chill likewise. Let the festivities begin!
