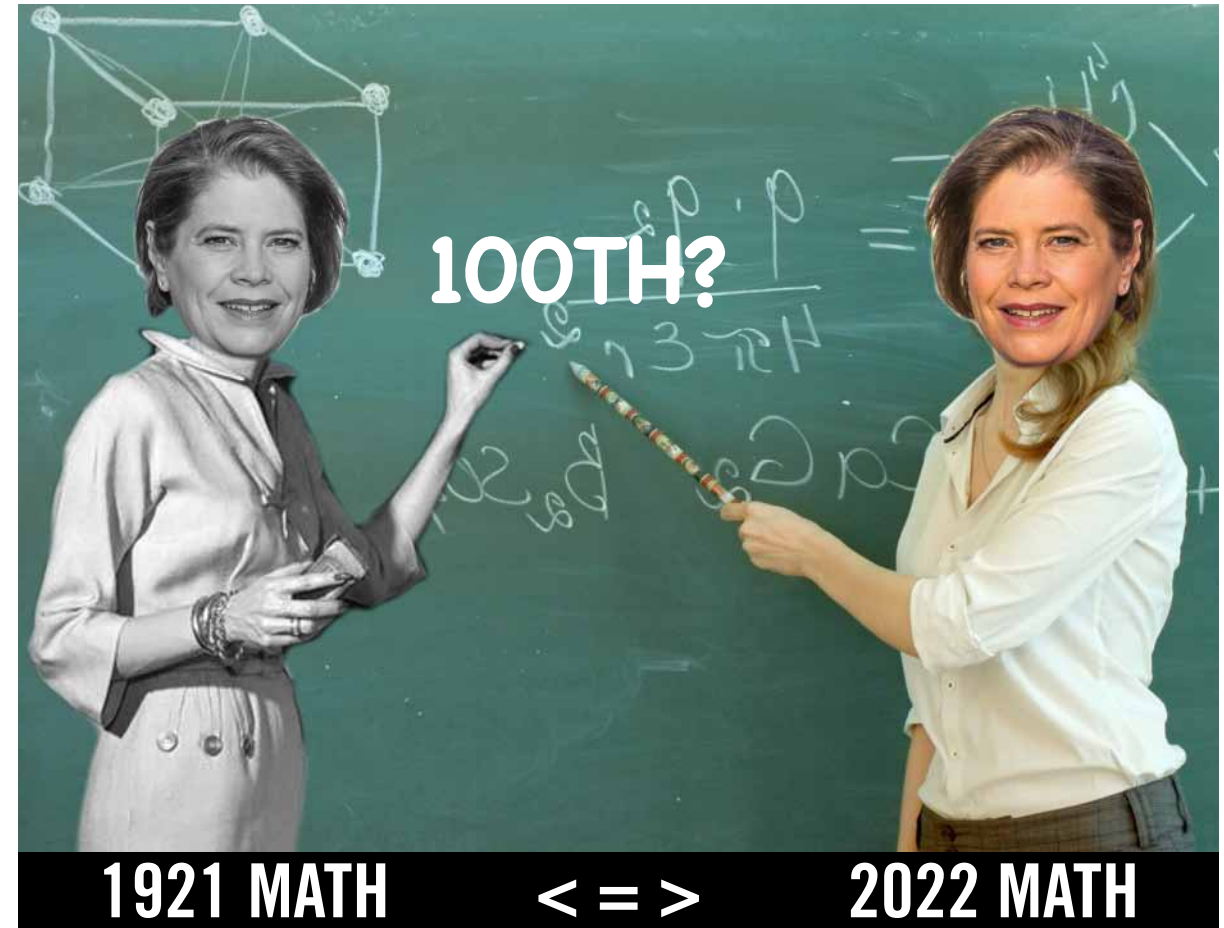

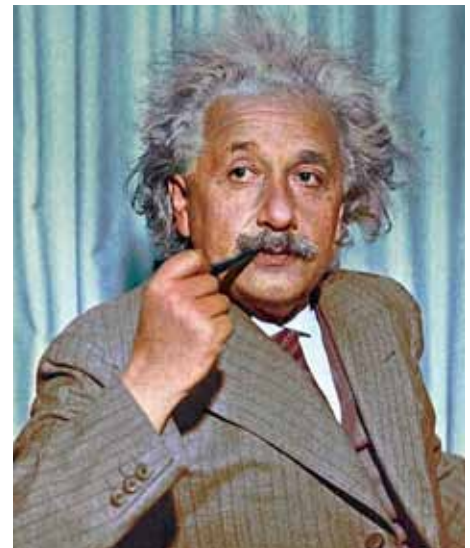
NEW ROTARY MATH?
