



The Swierczynski Swizzle Schtick

Do you know what the highest court in the land is? Nope. Even higher – read on. This week in history: In 2006, Twitter co-founder lack Dorsey sent the first public tweet, "Just setting up my Twttr." (duh) In 1980, WHO SHOT J.R.? was shown this week, one of the most famous cliffhangers in American television history (well, television only has three stations in those days and, uh, never mind) . But I'm burying the lede here: this week in 1939, Ohio State Coach Howard Olsen (no relation, not even spelled the same way, just ask Dave and while you're at it ask him why it's spelled LEDE and not LEAD) started a single elimination basketball tournament for eight colleges, yup, the original March Madness which now wrangles 68 schools (including the pride of Jersey City, the St. Peter's Peacocks, which only Andrew DeFranza picked to beat Kentucky). MARCH MAD-NESS, that's right. Which brings us to the highest court in the land: the basketball court/gymnasium above the Supreme Court chambers. Which reminds me of the most accomplished athlete to serve on the Supreme Court, Justice Byron Raymond White. White was nominated by IFK, the first Supreme Court Justice from Colorado, and served from 1962 – 1993. "Battering Byron" which he was never called played football, basketball, and baseball for the University of Colorado, was a Heisman Trophy finalist, and a first round draft pick for the Pittsburgh Steelers where he led the NFL in rushing his rookie year. After he was accepted at Yale Law, White played two seasons with the Detroit Lions 1940 – 1941. You can bet this guy used the gym upstairs when the Supreme Court was not in session. So this month's Madness mixture is called "A Long Drink of Anything But Water" in honor of the Justice White and made with Colorado Spring Water: 1/2 oz Tequila; 1/2 oz grapefruit juice; I tsp Orgeat Syrup; Spring Water. Shake with ice and strain into an old-fashioned glass. Fill with spring water and garnish with mint sprigs. Cheers to March Madness!
