



Tom Hankard, member of the Rotary Club of Belle Isle, is the current District Governor Designee (which means in 815 days he will be DG) and here to speak to us about RI Annual Fund.

Thanks to the plungers, we raised \$41,000 in the district. The polio vaccine costs 60 cents, so we save 70,000 kids with that amount of money raised!

Tom is visiting clubs the rest of this year to talk about the Annual Fund to raise awareness and encourage contributions. He has learned so much of what the Foundation does on local, re-

Beverly Rotary has an application through the Annual Fund when approved. Money to fund these types of projects comes from the Annual Fund, which comes from donations from around the world.

In 1917, the first donation to the fund was \$26.50. 5% goes to fees and costs of the Foundation, 47.5% goes to the ternationally, and 47.5% goes to a District Designated Fund, which invests it for 3 years. You can give through Rotary Direct, and applications are on each table. The number of participants is more important than a particular

amount given, but it would be amazing if every Rotarian could give \$26.50.

The Swierczynski Swizzle Schtick

Let's talk runners, Rotarians, No. I don't mean a tablecloth. The Boston Marathon reopened this week! I'm talking long distance runners or sprinters or joggers or relay teams - any kind of rapid perambulation. Retired Supreme Court Justice David Souter (aka "the Melrose meteor") was a jogger, though unfortunately not fast enough: in 2004, he was mugged while jogging in his DC neighborhood. His assailants took nothing but left a few bruises. And of course, lustice Clarence Thomas is known for his running of the bull but that's a story for another day. Perhaps the most noted runner of the nation's Highest Court is Justice Charles Evans Hughes, former Governor of New York, who was nominated to the Supreme Court in 1910 by President William Howard Taft (who was famous for running water in his custom bathtub in Beverly - see "story for another day" above). Hughes resigned from the Supreme Court in June 1916 after the Republican Party nominated him to run for President against Woodrow Wilson. A 6-month presidential campaign? That's a sprint! The Republican platform that year was voting rights for women and avoiding war with Mexico. What is this? Bizarro world? Hughes ran a good campaign but Wilson won a second term. In 1921, Hughes served as Secretary of State for Warren G. Harding and in 1930 Herbert Hoover re-nominated Hughes to the Supreme Court. Lo and behold, Hughes replaced retiring Justice, former President, and perennial bath runner, William Howard Taft - is that a relay team or not?
