The Gabriel Goblet of Good things

Readers, we’ve secretly exchanged the “swizzle” with a Gabriel Goblet.Wait you say what exactly is a goblet? Lets turn to dictionary:

gob· let (gob’lit) n.

1.A drinking vessel, such as a glass, that has a stem and base. Size typically fills with a flagon of water. **WAIT** whats a **flagon**? Again we turn to dictionary

flag· on (flag’en) n.

1.A large vessel, usually of metal or pottery, with a handle and spout and often a lid, used for holding wine or other liquors (water).

Well that explains nothing, but we know you can sometimes find a goblet down at Bootstraps thrift store. Now Sue is busy and doesn’t have time for all that drinking lawyers seem to regal in like previous columns. Feeding people is a 24/7 endeavor so sometimes she just needs something quick to take the edge off. This cocktail couldn’t be simpler with only 3 ingredients, shaken and served. We love garnishing with a lime wheel and a bit of lime zest to get some of the intense lime taste that comes from the oils that are released when a lime is zested.You’ll enjoy the quickness of it all.
We offer up the “Gabriel Gimlet”-
Ingredients: 2 1/2 oz.gin, 3/4 oz.simple syrup , 3/4 oz.lime juice, Ice, for shaking
Lime zest and wheel, for garnish
Directions combine gin, simple syrup and lime juice in a shaker. Shake for 10 to 15 seconds until the shaker is frosty. Strain into a coupe glass (or goblet if you prefer) and garnish with lime zest over top and a lime wheel on the rim.
If you’re able to snare a smoking jacket and ascot at thrift store it would be even more special. Raise your goblet and enjoy a flagon of Gimlet.
